Bursary fund

Claremont Fan Court School is committed to supporting pupils who are able to achieve our minimum academic requirements and contribute positively within our ethos. We understand that an independent school education is not attainable for everyone and we are pleased to offer a range of bursaries to support children who can truly thrive here, but who might otherwise not be able to attend. Heritage fund

As custodians of the school's Grade 1 landscape and listed buildings we take our responsibility very seriously. Each year we schedule a programme of repair and reinstatement work, which ensures that our school site and buildings are maintained and preserved for future generations. Donations to our heritage fund allow us to complete projects beyond the ongoing immediate maintenance requirements.

Building development fund

The school has a 15 year master plan to upgrade the site and buildings. These improvements will recognise the importance of this Grade 1 listed site and respect the heritage value of the landscape and buildings.

Phase one includes the new science and technology building, completed in September 2019, and extensive renovation of the Prep School was completed in 2021. Phase two of the project will include the redevelopment of the Joyce Grenfell Centre (JGC) to include a dedicated sixth form centre and a new school library, as well as upgrading our music school and transforming our hall into a larger performing arts space with a smaller concert hall.

The multipurpose pitch guarantees the school is able to play sports in all weather conditions, throughout the year. Shared between the Senior and Prep School, the pitch will diversify the sports on offer to students. As with many other schools in the area, the artificial sports pitch expands the number of sports on offer. The development team is currently planning the fundraising campaign for the pitch and would be delighted to hear from anyone considering supporting this project.

While phase one of our master plan is funded primarily through reinvestment, work on the later phases of the project will be contingent on fundraising.
